

Federico Beauty Institute signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used no less than 50% of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

Federico Beauty Institute has received \$269,448.00 from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

Federico Beauty Institute has distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act \$252,310.02 as of July 29, 2020.
